In a large part of pre-Columbian cultures, like the Mayan or the Aztec, **the snail** had a large symbolism. Its shell cut in section, showing the spiral, was used as a **voice transmitter of the gods** to the people, as it was hanging on the priests' chest.

Breath that goes to the enigmatic spiral and becomes sound vibration, wind music, calling to the wake-up"

PROJECT

After almost a decade together, since our superior studies were completed, we have achieved a combination of experience, professionalism and freshness that we always want to transmit in our performances.

In our career, the spotlights are the **two published CD**. In the first one, *UNUA* (2012), where we show our potential covering pieces of all styles. Secondly and on request, *SAXOFONIA* (2014) a monographic of the prestigious composer Andrés Valero-Castells. The group is immersed in a new record project that it is soon to go to display.

We have make concerts around all **Spanish geography** and for that reason, we have been given a position of great appreciation in the last years, in particular thanks to our performance in Radio Nacional de España in 2012. Likewise, the concert **Europe tours** in countries like France, Holland or Lithuania, it made possible to give to know our work at an international level.

Especially interested in new creation repertoire, we work frequently with great composers like José Rafael Pascual-Vilaplana, José Ignacio Blesa Lull, Antón Alcalde, Daan van der Hurk or the above mentioned Andrés Valero-Castells. Result of that, the quartet has several pieces dedicated to the group.

In many instances, we **share stage** with famous saxophonists like Mariano García, Antonio Felipe Belijar, David Pons or Johan van der Linden, and we usually work with The World Orchestra under the baton of Josep Vicent, and in various seminar of Berklee College of Music together with the conductor Rafael Sanz-Espert. As a guest group we have participated in the **V Ibero-American Congress of composers** under the baton of the Brazilian Marcelo Maganha, and also in the project "Música a la llum", together with Pablo Marqués Mestre.

In the development of our pedagogic work we annually organized our **own festival, SAXEM**, where we gathered some of the best teachers and saxophonists in the world, and more than sixty students who participate in workshops, conferences, classes and concerts that the festival offer, usually by the end of April.

We are very proud to attract many people and fill important auditory, in which we are received as the best critics in first-hand:


